50 BIBLICAL IDENTIFICATION MARKS THAT PROVE THAT THE JEWS ARE NOT TRUE ISRAEL

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1. Have the Jews blessed all the nations of the earth?

- <u>Genesis 12:3</u> states, "And I (YAHWEH) will bless them, who bless thee (Abraham); and those who curse thee I will curse: and by thee all the tribes of the earth shalt be blessed."
- <u>Genesis 22:18</u> states, "and by the seed of thee (Abraham) all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because thou hast hearkened to My (YAHWEH) voice."

2. Are the Jews circumcised in heart?

- <u>Deuteronomy 10:16</u> states, "Circumcise therefore the stubbornness of your (Israel) hearts, and be no more stiffnecked."
- <u>Deuteronomy 30:6</u> states, "And the Lord will purify thy (Israel) heart, and the heart of thy seed, to love the Lord thy God with thy whole heart, and with thy whole soul, that thou mayst live."
- <u>Romans 2:28</u> states, "For he is not a Jew, who is one outwardly; nor is that circumcision, which is barely in the flesh: but he, who is a Jew inwardly, whose circumcision is that of the heart spiritually not literally, whose praise is not from men, but from God.

2. Are the Jews circumcised in heart?

- <u>Philippians 3:3</u> states, "Beware of the dogs; beware of the evil workers; beware of the concision; for we are the circumcision, who serve God in spirit, and glory in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in flesh."
- <u>Colossians 2:9-12</u> state, "Because all the plenitude of the deity resideth substantially in Him, therefore you are complete in Him who is the head of all principality and power; in whom also you have been circumcised with a circumcision made without hands – with the putting off of the body of the sins of the flesh – with the circumcision of the Christ; having been buried with Him in that baptism in which also you were raised with Him by your belief in the mighty power of God, who raised Him from the dead."

3. Have the Jews ever glorified Jesus Christ, and has He been recognized by the Jewish nation?

- <u>Isaiah 41:16</u> states, "thou (Israel) shalt grind mountains and reduce hills to small pieces, and make them (Jews) like dust: and thou shalt winnow them; and a wind shall take them up, and a whirlwind shall sweep them away; but thou shalt be gladdened in the sanctuaries of Israel;"
- <u>Luke 1:32-33</u> state, "And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever. And of His Kingdom there shall be no end."
- <u>Luke 7:16</u> states, "And He delivered him to his mother. And a dread fell upon all; and they glorified God, saying, A great prophet is risen up among us, and God hath visited His People."

4. Do the Jews declare that Jesus Christ is the Lord God of Israel of the Old Testament?

- <u>Isaiah 43:10-12</u> state, "Be you (Israel) witnesses for Me (YAHWEH): and as for Me I Myself am a witness saith the Lord God; and this servant of Mine whom I have chosen; that you may know and believe and understand that with respect to Me, *The I Am*, There is no other God before Me; and after Me none will exist. I am God and there is no Savior besides Me. I have announced and saved; I reproached when there was no strange god among you. You are witnesses for Me;"
- <u>Isaiah 44:8</u> states, "Hide not yourselves nor be led astray. Have you not heard from the beginning? And have I not told you? You are witnesses whether there be any god besides Me."

4. Do the Jews declare that Jesus Christ is the Lord God of Israel of the Old Testament?

• Isaiah 49:3-6 state, "and said to me, Thou, Israel, art My servant and by thee I shall be glorified. Whereupon I said, I have labored in vain; for vanity and for nought I have spent my strength; therefore, my cause is with the Lord, and my labor is before my God. And now thus saith the Lord, and my labor is before my God. And now thus saith the Lord, Who formed me from the womb to be His servant, to gather Jacob to Him, and Israel. I shall be gathered and glorified before the Lord. And my God will be my strength. Moreover, He said to me, It is a great thing for thee to be called My servant to re-establish the tribes of Jacob and bring back the dispersion of Israel. Behold I have given thee for the everlasting testament of a race – for the light of nations; that thou mayst be for salvation to the farthest part of the earth."

4. Do the Jews declare that Jesus Christ is the Lord God of Israel of the Old Testament?

- <u>Isaiah 52:6</u> states, "Thus saith the Lord, On your account My name is continually reviled among the nations. Therefore in that day My people shall know My name. Because I *The I Am*, the same Who am speaking, am at hand,"
- <u>Acts 1:8</u> states, "But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit is come upon you; and you shall be witnesses for Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea, and Samaria, and to the remotest part of the earth."

5. Do the Jews show forth the praise of Jesus Christ?

• <u>Isaiah 43:21</u> states, "My people whom I have preserved to recount My praises."

6. Have the Jews carried the Gospel to all the world and witnessed for Jesus Christ and held the Bible open?

- <u>Genesis 28:14</u> states, "And thy (Abraham) seed shall be as the dust of the earth and shall spread abroad to the west and to the south, and the north and the east. And by thee all the tribes of the earth shall be blessed, namely by the seed of thee."
- <u>Isaiah 43:10</u> states, "Be you witnesses for Me: and as for Me I Myself am a witness saith the Lord God; and this servant of Mine whom I have chosen; that you may know and believe and understand that with respect to me,"
- <u>Isaiah 44:21</u> states, "Remember these things, O Jacob, even thou Israel, for thou art My servant. I have made thee My servant; therefore O Israel do not thou forget Me."

6. Have the Jews carried the Gospel to all the world and witnessed for Jesus Christ and held the Bible open?

• Isaiah 49:3-6 states, "and said to me, Thou, Israel, art My servant and by thee I shall be glorified. Whereupon I said, I have labored in vain; for vanity and for nought I have spent my strength; therefore, my cause is with the Lord, and my labor is before my God. And now thus saith the Lord, and my labor is before my God. And now thus saith the Lord, Who formed me from the womb to be His servant, to gather Jacob to Him, and Israel. I shall be gathered and glorified before the Lord. And my God will be my strength. Moreover, He said to me, It is a great thing for thee to be called My servant to re-establish the tribes of Jacob and bring back the dispersion of Israel. Behold I have given thee for the everlasting testament of a race – for the light of nations; that thou mayst be for salvation to the farthest part of the earth."

• <u>Acts 1:8</u> states, "But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit is come upon you; and you shall be witnesses for Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea, and Samaria, and to the remotest part of the earth."

7. Do the Jews have God's Spirit and the Word of God in their mouth and their uttermost being?

• <u>Isaiah 59:21</u> states, "And this shall be My covenant with them, said the Lord, this Spirit of Mine which is upon thee, and these words which I have put in thy mouth shall not fail from thy mouth, nor from the mouth of thy seed, (for the Lord hath spoken) from this time forth forever."

8. Has the new covenant been written only to the Jews? The Bible states that it has been made with the House of Israel and with the House of Judah.

• Jeremiah 31:31-33 state, "Behold the days are coming, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Juda. Not according to the covenant which I made with their fathers on the day when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt. Because they did not abide by this covenant of Mine, therefore I took no care of them. For this, saith the Lord, is My covenant which I will make with the house of Israel: After those days, saith the Lord, I will adapt My laws to their understanding and write them on their hearts, and I will be their God and they shall be My people."

8. Has the new covenant been written only to the Jews? The Bible states that it has been made with the House of Israel and with the House of Judah.

- <u>Matthew 26:28</u> states, "For this is My blood that of the new covenant that shed for many, for the remission of sins."
- <u>Hebrews 8:8</u> states, "Behold days are coming, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and the house of Juda"

9. Are the Jews the sheep of Israel?

- <u>Ezekiel 34:11-12</u> state, "For thus saith the Lord God: Lo! I Myself will seek My sheep and watch over them. As a shepherd searcheth for his flock when mist and murky air overspread his scattered sheep: so will I diligently seek My sheep, and bring them from every place, where they have been dispersed in the day of mist and murky darkness."
- <u>Psalm 78:52</u> states, "and brough out His people like sheep, and led them like a flock in the desert,"
- <u>Psalm 95:1</u> states, "O COME, let us sing with joy to the Lord; let us shout triumphantly to God our Savior:"
- <u>Psalm</u> 95:5-7 state, "O come, let us worship and bow down before Him, and let us weep before the Lord, our Maker. Because He is our God, and we are the people of His pasture, and the flock of His hand;"

9. Are the Jews the sheep of Israel?

• <u>Isaiah 53:5-7</u> state, "But He was wounded for our sins, and afflicted for our iniquities. The chastisement of our peace was upon Him; by His bruises we are healed. We all like sheep had strayed; every man wandered in his way: and the Lord delivered Him up for our sins: and He, on account of His affliction, openeth not His mouth."

9. Are the Jews the sheep of Israel?

• <u>Matthew 15:24</u> states, "And He in reply said, My mission is only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel."

9. Are the Jews the sheep of Israel

• John 10:22-27 state, "When they were celebrating the dedication festival at Jerusalem, and it was stormy weather; and Jesus was walking in the temple in Solomon's portico; the Jews again came around Him, and said to Him, How long dost thou keep us in suspense? If thou art the Christ, tell us plainly: Jesus answered them, I told you but you do not believe. The works which I do in My Father's name – these testify concerning Me. But you do not believe, for you are not of My sheep. My sheep, as I told you, hearken to My voice and I know them, and they follow Me: and I give them everlasting life; and they shall never perish, nor shall any one wrest them out of My hand."

10. Are the Jews the children of God scattered abroad?

- John 7:35 states, "Upon this, the Jews said among themselves, Whither is He going, that we shall not find Him? Is He going to the dispersed among the Greeks, to teach the Greeks?"
- John 10:14-16 state, "I am the good shepherd and I know mine own sheep, and am known by them who are mine, even as the Father knoweth Me, and I know the Father; and I lay down My life for the sheep. Now I have other sheep which are not of this fold. These also I must lead; they will hearken to My voice, and there shall be one flock and one shepherd."

10. Are the Jews the children of God scattered abroad?

• John 11:51-53 state, "Now this he (Caiaphas) said not merely of himself, but being high priest that year, he prophesied that Jesus was soon to die for that nation, and not for that nation only, but that He might gather into one body the children of God who were scattered abroad. From that day therefore they (the Pharisees) consulted together that they might put Him to death."

11. Is Jesus Christ glorified in the Jews?

- <u>Isaiah 49:1-3</u> state, "HEARKEN to me, O isles; and ye nations attend: after a long time one will arise, saith the Lord. From my mother's womb He mentioned my name and made my mouth like a sharp sword and hid me under the cover of His hand. He made me like a chosen shaft, and in His quiver kept me concealed, and said to me, <u>Thou, Israel, art My servant and</u> by thee I shall be glorified."
- <u>Romans 8:29-30</u> state, "For those whom He foreknew, even these He marked out beforehand to be of a form the same as that of the image of His Son, that He might be a first born among many brethren. And those whom He marked out beforehand He actually called, and those whom He called, even these He acquitted, and those whom He acquitted even these He glorified."

11. Is Jesus Christ glorified in the Jews?

• <u>Romans 9:1-6</u> state, "I speak the truth in Christ, I lie not, my conscience, with a holy spirit, bearing joint witness for me that I have great grief and incessant sorrow in my heart (for I even I myself wished the followers of Christ to be devoted to destruction,) for my brethren, my kinsmen according to the flesh, who are Israelites, to whom belonged the adoption and the glory, and the covenants, and the civil government, and the religious service, and the promises; whose ancestors were the patriarchs, and from whom, with regard to flesh, the Christ is [descended] who is over all, God blessed forever. Amen. It is not however to be supposed that the word of God hath failed."

11. Is Jesus Christ glorified in the Jews?

• <u>Romans 11:1-2</u> state, "(J) I say then, Hath God utterly rejected His people? (A) No, by no means. For even I myself am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, of the tribe of Benjamin. God hath not utterly rejected His people whom He heretofore acknowledged."

12. Are the Jews servants of God?

- <u>Isaiah 41:8</u> states, "but thou Israel My servant; thou Jacob, whom I have chosen; thou seed of Abraham whom I loved!"
- <u>Isaiah 43:5-8</u> state, "Fear not. Because I am with thee, from the east I will bring thy seed, and gather thee together from the west: I will say to the north, Give up; and to the south, Keep thou not back; bring My sons from afar and My daughters from the ends of the earth all that are called by My name. For I have prepared him for My glory, I have fashioned him and made him, and <u>have brought out a blind people: for their eyes are as if they were blind; and they are deaf, though they have ears</u>."
- <u>Isaiah 49:3</u> states, "and said to me, Thou, Israel, art My servant and by thee I shall be glorified."

13. Are the Jews a holy nation, a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a peculiar people?

- <u>Exodus 19:5-6</u> state, "Now therefore if you will hearken diligently to My voice and keep My covenant, you shall be to Me a peculiar people above all the nations; for the whole earth is Mine: but as for you, you shall be a royal priesthood and a holy nation. These words thou shalt deliver to the children of Israel."
- <u>Deuteronomy 7:6</u> states, "For thou art a people dedicated to the Lord thy God, and the Lord thy God hath chosen thee, to be a peculiar people to Himself, <u>in preference to all the nations which are on the face of the earth</u>."
- <u>Deuteronomy 14:2</u> states, "Because thou art a people dedicated to the Lord thy God, and the Lord thy God hath chosen thee to be a peculiar people to Himself, <u>above all the nations on the face of the earth</u>."

13. Are the Jews a holy nation, a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a peculiar people?

- <u>I Peter 1:1-2</u> state, "PETER, an apostle of Jesus Christ, to the sojourners of the dispersion in Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia and Bithynia, whom God the Father, according to His predetermination hath chosen, that by a sanctification of spirit they may obey, and be sprinkled with the blood of Jesus Christ; favor be to you, and may peace be multiplied."
- <u>I Peter 2:9-10</u> state, "They (the Jews) disbelieving the Word stumble at the thing for which they were laid: but you (Israel) being a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people peculiarly set apart that you may publish the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light you who formerly were not a people but are now the people of God who were uncompassionated, but are now compassionated, beloved;"

14. Are the Jews the great characters mentioned in the great faith chapter of Hebrews 11?

• Abel, Enoch, Noah, Abraham, Sarah, Isaak, Jacob, Joseph, Moses, The Israelites, Rahab, Gideon, Barak, Sampson, Jephthae, David, Samuel, and the Prophets were NOT Jews.

15. Are the Jews a "righteous nation"?

• <u>Isaiah 26:2-4</u> state, "Open the gates; let the people enter, who keep righteousness and who keep truth; who support truth and keep peace; because their confidence is placed in Thee, O Lord! Who art to everlasting, the Mighty, the Eternal God,"

16. Are the Jews bringing forth the fruits of the kingdom?

- <u>Hosea 14:8</u> states, "As for Ephraim, what hath he any more to do with idols? I humbled him and I will strengthen him. I am like a fruitful juniper; from Me thou shalt find fruit."
- <u>Matthew 21:43</u> states, "Therefore I say to you, The kingdom of God shall be taken from you (the Jews)and given to a nation (Israel) producing the fruits thereof."

• <u>Leviticus 19:33-34</u> state, "I am the Lord your God; if any stranger come among you in your land, you shall not afflict him. The stranger who cometh to you, shall be as one born among you; and thou shalt love him as thyself; for you were strangers in the land of Egypt."

• Matthew 25:31-36 state, "So when the Son of Man shall come in His glory, and all the holy angels with Him; He will then sit on the throne of His glory. And before Him shall be assembled all the nations. And He will separate them one from another, as a shepherd separateth the sheep from the goats. And He will place the sheep on the right hand and goats on His left. Then the King will say to them on His right, Come ye blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom which hath been prepared for you from the formation of the world: for I was hungry, and you gave Me food; I was thirsty, and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger, and you lodged Me; naked, and you clothed Me; sick, and you took care of Me; I was in prison, and you visited Me."

• Matthew 25:37-43 state, "Then the righteous will answer Him, saying, Lord, when did we see Thee hungry, and feed thee; or thirsty, and give Thee drink? When saw we Thee a stranger, and lodged Thee; or naked, and clothed Thee? Or when saw we thee sick, or in prison, and came to Thee? And the King, in reply will say to them, Verily I say to you, Inasmuch as you have done this to one of these My brethren, even the least, you have done it to Me. Then He will say to them on His left, Depart from Me, ye cursed, into the fire which is everlasting – that prepared for the devil and his angels! For I was hungry, and you gave Me no food; I was thirsty, and you gave Me no drink; I was a stranger, and you did not lodge Me; naked, and you did not clothe Me; sick, and in prison, and you did not visit Me."

• <u>Matthew 25:44-46</u> state, "Then they also will answer Him, saying, Lord, when did we see Thee hungry, or thirsty, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not minister to Thee? And He will answer them, saying, Verily I say to you, Inasmuch as you have not done this to any, the least of these, you have not done it to Me. So, these shall go to everlasting punishment and the righteous to an everlasting life."

18. Are the Jews called, the "sons of the living God"?19. Do the Jews claim to be "not God's people"?

• <u>Hosea 1:10</u> states, "(Now the number of the children of Israel was like the sand of the sea which cannot be measured nor counted.) But it shall come to pass that in the place where it was said to them, You are not My people, they shall be called children of the Living God;"

20. Do the Jews have all of God's Word?

- <u>Deuteronomy 33:4</u> states, "From His words Moses received the law which he gave in charge to us, an inheritance for the assemblies of Jacob."
- <u>Psalm 147:19-20</u> state, "He is sending His word to Jacob His statutes and His judgments to Israel. He hath not dealt thus with any nation, nor hath He laid open to them His judgments."

20. Do the Jews have all of God's Word?

• <u>Romans 9:1-6</u> state, "I speak the truth in Christ, I lie not, my conscience, with a holy spirit, bearing joint witness for me that I have great grief and incessant sorrow in my heart (for I even I myself wished the followers of Christ to be devoted to destruction,) for my brethren, my kinsmen according to the flesh, who are Israelites, to whom belonged the adoption and the glory, and the covenants, and the civil government, and the religious service, and the promises; whose ancestors were the patriarchs, and from whom, with regard to flesh, the Christ is [descended] who is over all, God blessed forever. Amen. It is not however to be supposed that the word of God hath failed."

21. Are the Jews a great and mighty nation?

• <u>Genesis 18:18</u> states, "Abraham shall indeed become a nation great and numerous; and by him all the nations of the earth are to be blessed."

22. Are the Jews today innumerable as the stars of heaven and as the sand of the seashore?

- <u>Genesis 22:17-18</u> state, "with blessings I will indeed bless thee; and I will multiply thy seed abundantly as the stars of heaven and as the sand of the seashore: and thy seed shall inherit the cities of their adversaries; and by the seed of thee all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because thou hast hearkened to My voice."
- <u>Hosea 1:10</u> states, "(Now the number of the children of Israel was like the sand of the sea which cannot be measured nor counted.) But it shall come to pass that in the place where it was said to them, You are not My people, they shall be called children of the Living God;"

23. Do the Jews possess the gates of their enemies?

- <u>Genesis 22:17-18</u> state, "with blessings I will indeed bless thee; and I will multiply thy seed abundantly as the stars of heaven and as the sand of the seashore: and thy seed shall inherit the cities of their adversaries; and by the seed of thee all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because thou hast hearkened to My voice."
- <u>Genesis 24:60</u> states, "And they blessed Rebekka and said to her, Thou art our sister. Mayest thou become thousands of myriads and may thy seed inherit the cities of their enemies."

24. Are the Jews a nation and a company of nations?

- <u>Genesis 35:11</u> states, "And God said to him (Jacob), I am thy God. Increase and multiply. Of thee shall be nations and collections of nations; and kings shall spring from thy loins."
- <u>Genesis 48:19</u> states, "But he (Jacob) refused, and said, I know; my son (Joseph); I know. This brother (Ephraim) will be greater than he (Manasses); and his (Ephraim) seed will be a multitude of nations."

25. Will the Jews push all the people together to the ends of the earth?

• <u>Deuteronomy 33:17</u> states, "His (Joseph) beauty is that of a firstling bull, his horns are the horns of an unicorn, with these he will push the nations at once, even from the limits of the land. These are the myriads of Ephraim; and these the thousands of Manasses."

26. Are the Jews above all the people on the face of the earth?

• <u>Deuteronomy 7:1-2</u> states, "NOW when the Lord thy God hath brought thee into that land, to which thou art going, there to possess it, and hath removed from before thee mighty nations – the Chettite, and the Gergasite, and the Amorite, and the Chananite, and the Pheresite, and the Evite, and the Jebusite, seven nations, more numerous, and stronger than you (Israel) – When the Lord thy God shall deliver them into thy hands, thou shalt smite them; thou shalt utterly destroy them; thou shalt not make a covenant with them."

26. Are the Jews above all the people on the face of the earth?

- <u>Deuteronomy 12:1-2</u> state, "NOW these are the commandments, and the judgments, which you (Israel) shall be careful to execute, in the land which the Lord the God of your fathers giveth you for a possession, all the days you live in the land. You shall utterly destroy all those places, in which they (the 7 nations of Chanan) whom you succeed, have worshipped their gods, on the lofty mountains, and on the hills, and under every shady tree."
- <u>Psalm 135:4-5</u> state, "For the Lord hath made choice of Jacob for Himself – of Israel for His peculiar treasure. For I know that the Lord is great, and that our Lord is above all the gods."

26. Are the Jews above all the people on the face of the earth?

• <u>Amos 3:1-2</u> state, "HEAR this word which the Lord hath spoken against you, O house of Israel! Yes, against every tribe which I brought out of the land of Egypt, saying, Of all the tribes of the earth, I acknowledge none but you. Therefore I will punish you for all your sins."

27. Have the Jews ever dwelled alone in a home appointed by God?

- <u>Numbers 23:9</u> states, "For from the top of mountains I can see him (Israel); even from hills I can observe him, <u>behold he shall dwell, as a people by themselves</u>, and shall not be reckoned among the nations."
- <u>II Samuel 7:10</u> states, "and I will appoint a place for My people Israel, and plant them, and they shall dwell by themselves, and shall no more be in trouble; nor shall a son of wickedness any more humble them as heretofore,"
- <u>I Chronicles 17:9</u> states, "and I will fix a place for My people Israel, and plant them, and they shall dwell by themselves and no more be in trouble, nor shall a son of iniquity any more humble them as at the first,"

27. Have the Jews ever dwelled alone in a home appointed by God?

- Jeremiah 3:18 states, "In those days the house of Juda shall unite with the house of Israel, and they shall come together from the land of the north and from all those countries, to the land which I put in possession of their fathers."
- <u>Ezekiel 36:24</u> states, "When I take you from among the nations, and gather you out of all the countries, and bring you into your own land;"
- <u>Acts 17:25-27</u> states, "He is the giver of life and breath, and of all things, to all, and hath made of one (blood) the whole nation of men to inhabit the whole face of the earth, having marked out times previously arranged in order, and the boundaries of their habitation, for them to seek the Lord if haply they might feel, and find Him, though He indeed is not far from any one of us."

28. Have the Jews a navy or naval power?

- <u>Numbers 24:7</u> states, "There shall come forth a Man from his (Jacob) seed, and He shall rule over many nations: and a kingdom greater than Gog's shall be raised up; and His kingdom shall be enlarged"
- <u>Isaiah 60: 5</u> states, "Then thou wilt look and be filled with awe and astonished at heart; because the riches of the sea and of nations and peoples will pour in upon thee."
- <u>Isaiah 60:9</u> states, "For Me the islands waited, and among the first the ships of Tharsis to bring thy children from afar and their silver and their gold with them. And because of the holy name of the Lord, and because the Holy One of Israel is glorious;"

29. Did or will the Jews eat up the nations, their enemies?

• <u>Number 24:8</u> states, "God hath led him (Israel) out of Egypt, his (Israel) glory is like that of the unicorn; he (Israel) will eat up the nations of his enemies; and he will exhaust their fatness, and pierce his enemy with his darts."

30. Are the Jews God's Battle Axe?

- <u>Numbers 24:8-9</u> state, "God hath led him (Israel) out of Egypt, his (Israel) glory is like that of the unicorn; he (Israel) will eat up the nations of his enemies; and he will exhaust their fatness, and pierce his enemy with his darts. Couching down, he is gone to rest, like a lion yes like a young lion; who dare rouse him? Blessed are they who bless thee, and they who curse thee are already cursed."
- <u>Isaiah 41:15-16</u> state, "Behold I have made thee (Israel) like the wheels of a wain bruising to pieces a brood of pigeons: thou indeed shalt grind mountains and reduce hill to small pieces, and make them like dust: and thou shalt winnow them; and a wind shall take them up, and a whirlwind shall sweep them away; but thou shalt be gladdened in the sanctuaries of Israel;"

30. Are the Jews God's Battle Axe?

• Jeremiah 51:20-24 state, "In those days and at that time, search shall be made for the iniquity of Israel; but none shall remain; and for the sins of Juda, but none shall be found. For I will be merciful to them who are left. With respect to this land, saith the Lord. Go up with bitterness against it and against them who dwell in it; take vengeance, O sword, and destroy utterly; saith the Lord, and do according to all that I command thee. A sound of battle and great distress in the land of this Chaldeans! How the hammer of the whole earth is broken and dashed to pieces! How Babylon is become a desolation among the nations! They will come upon thee and thou shalt not know – like Babylon itself and thou shalt be taken. Thou art found out and taken, because thou didst set thyself against the Lord."

31. Are the Jews feared by all nations?

- <u>Deuteronomy 2:25</u> states, "Begin to impress the fear of thee (Israel), and the dread of thee, on the face of all the nations under heaven. They who hear of thy name shall tremble, and be in anguish because of thee."
- <u>Deuteronomy 28:9-10</u> state, "The Lord establish thee (Israel) a holy people for Himself, as He solemnly promised thy fathers. If thou wilt hearken to the voice of the Lord thy God, and walk in all His ways, then shall all the nations of the earth see that thou art called by the name of the Lord, and they will be afraid of thee;"

32. Are the Jews a mighty nation, crushing and grinding to powder all who oppose them?

- <u>Daniel 2:44</u> states, "And in the days of those kings (Babylon, Medo-Persia, Greece, and Rome), the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which shall never be destroyed; and this kingdom of His shall not be left to another people. It shall break in pieces and blow away all those kingdoms, and shall itself stand forever."
- <u>Matthew 21:43-44</u> state, "Therefore I say to you (house of Juda), The kingdom of God shall be taken from you and given to a nation (house of Israel) producing the fruits thereof. And he who falleth on that stone will be bruised, but on whomsoever it shall fall, it will grind him to powder."

33. Have the Jews inherited the "Gentiles"?

• <u>Isaiah 54:3</u> states, "When Thou (YAHWEH) executes Thy glorious works, because of Thee terror will seize the mountains."

34. Is it possible to count one-fourth of the Jews or all of them?

• <u>Numbers 23:10</u> states, "Who hath accurately scanned the seed of Jacob? Who can count the communities of Israel? May my soul depart among the souls of the righteous! And my offspring be as the seed of these!"

35. Are the Jews the rod of God's inheritance?

- <u>Psalm 135:4</u> states, "For the Lord hath made choice of Jacob for Himself of Israel for His peculiar treasure."
- <u>Isaiah 19:24-25</u> state, "In that day Israel shall be a third, among the Egyptians and among the Assyrians, blessed in the land which the Lord of Hosts hath blessed saying, Blessed is My people which is in Egypt, and which is in Assyria and Israel which is My inheritance."

36. Do the Jews today have an earthly king of the lineage of David ruling over them? If they are Israel, then a Davidic king must be among them somewhere.

- <u>Psalm 89:24-29</u> state, "And My truth and My mercy shall be with him; and by My name his horn shall be exalted. And I will put his hand on the sea; and his right hand on the rivers: and he will invoke Me saying, Thou art my father; my God and the support of my salvation; and I will set him as a first-born; high above all the kings of the earth. My mercy I will keep for him evermore. And My covenant with him shall be firm. And I will establish his seed forever, and his throne as the days of heaven."
- <u>Psalm 89:35-37</u> state, "Once for all I have sworn by My holiness; that I will not be false to David. His seed shall endure forever, and his throne as the sun before Me; and as the moon forever fixed: and the witness in heaven is faithful."

36. Do the Jews today have an earthly king of the lineage of David ruling over them? If they are Israel, then a Davidic king must be among them somewhere.

• Jeremiah 33:17 (KJV) states, "For thus saith the LORD; David shall never want a man to sit upon the throne of the house of David."

37. Are the Jews called today through Isaac (Isaac's sons or Saxons)?

- <u>Genesis 21:12</u> states, "But God said to Abraham, Let not this respecting thy son and respecting the handmaid appear hard in thy view. Hearken to the voice of Sarah in whatever she may have said to thee. For in Isaak a seed (Jacob/Israel) shall be called for thee."
- <u>Genesis 35:11</u> states, "And God said to him (Jacob/Israel), I am thy God. Increase and multiply. Of thee shall be nations and collections of nations; and kings shall spring from thy loins."
- <u>Amos 7:16 (KJV)</u> states, "Now therefore hear thou the word of the LORD: Thou sayest, Prophesy not against Israel, and drop not thy word against the house of Isaac."

37. Are the Jews called today through Isaac (Isaac's sons or Saxons)?

- <u>Romans 9:7</u> states, "For with regard to all the descendants of Israel, they are not Israel; nor are they all children, because they are of the race of Abraham; but in Isaak a seed shall be called for thee."
- <u>Hebrews 11:18</u> states, "By faith Abraham, when he was put to the trial, offered up Isaak. Though he had received the promises, he offered up his only begotten son, in respect to whom it had been said, that "in Isaak a seed shall be called for tee," reckoning that God was able to raise him up, even from the dead, from which in a figurative sense, he had received him."

38. Will the Jews say that they have lost their lineage or identity?

- <u>Deuteronomy 32:26</u> states, "I (YAHWEH) had determined to disperse them (Israel), and cause the remembrance of them to cease among men;"
- Jeremiah 50:6-7 state, "My people (Israel) have been lost sheep. Their shepherds caused them to stray. On the mountains they caused them to wander. From mountain to hill they roamed. They forgot their place of rest. All that found them devoured them. Their enemies said, Let us not spare them because they sinned against the Lord. He Who gathered their fathers hath a pasture of righteousness:"

38. Will the Jews say that they have lost their lineage or identity?

- <u>Hosea 1:8-10</u> state, "And when she had weaned *No-compassionated*, she conceived again and bore a son, and He said, Call his name *Not-My-people* and I am not your God. (Now the number of the children of Israel was like the sand of the sea which cannot be measured nor counted.) But it shall come to pass that in the place where it was said to them, You are not My people, they shall be called children of the Living God."
- <u>Hosea 2:6</u> states, "For this, behold, I will hedge up her (Israel) way with thorns, and block up her ways that she may not find her path."

38. Will the Jews say that they have lost their lineage or identity?

- <u>Hosea 8:8</u> states, "[As it is,] Israel is swallowed up he is now among the nations like a useless vessel, because he went up to the Assyrians."
- <u>Hosea 9:17</u> states, "God will cast them (Israel) off because they hearkened not to Him; and they shall be wanderers among the nations."
- <u>Isaiah 1:3</u> states, "The ox knoweth his owner, and the ass his master's crib; but Israel did not know Me (YAHWEH). And this people have not regarded Me."
- <u>Isaiah 42:19</u> states, "Who indeed is blind but My servants (Israel)? And deaf, but those who rule over them? Even the servants of God are become blind."

39. Do the Jews have a new name and a new language today?

- <u>Isaiah 28:11</u> states, "On account of the mockery of their lips because they will speak to this people with strange tongue, saying to them,"
- <u>Isaiah 62:2</u> states, "and nations see thy righteousness, and kings this glory of thine. When he shall call thee by a new name which the Lord Himself will give thee (Israel)."
- <u>Isaiah 65:15</u> states, "For you (the Jews) shall leave your name for a loathing to My chosen (Israel). As for you, the Lord will destroy you; but to My servants, a new name shall be given which shall be blessed on the earth: for they will bless the true God: and they who swear on the earth, will swear by the true God."

39. Do the Jews have a new name and a new language today?

- <u>Hosea 1:10</u> states, "(Now the number of the children of Israel was like the sand of the sea which cannot be measured nor counted.) But it shall come to pass that in the place where it was said to them, You are not My people, they shall be called children of the Living God."
- <u>Acts 11:26</u> states, "And for a whole year they assembled with this congregation, and taught a considerable multitude. And the disciples at Antioch first got the name of *Christian*.

39. Do the Jews have a new name and a new language today?

- <u>Romans 9:25-27</u> state, "As He actually saith by Hosea, "I will call them My people who are not My people; and I will call her beloved, who was not beloved. And it shall come to pass that in the place where it was said to them, You are not My people, they shall there be called children of the living God." Esais also crieth concerning Israel, "Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, this remnant shall be saved."
- <u>I Peter 2:9-10</u> state, "They disbelieving the word stumble at the thing for which they were laid: but you (Israel) being a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people peculiarly set apart that you may publish the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light you who formerly were not a people but are now the people of God who were uncompassionated, but are now compassionated, beloved;"

- <u>Read Genesis 48</u> The blessings by Jacob/Israel to Joseph and his two sons, Ephraim and Manasses in the latter days.
- <u>Read Genesis 49</u> The blessings by Jacob/Israel to his 12 sons in the latter days.
- <u>Read Deuteronomy 33</u> The blessings by Moses to the children of Israel in the latter days.
- <u>Acts 2:16-18</u> state, "But this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel, "And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, that I will pour out a portion of My spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy; and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams; and upon My servants, and upon My handmaids, in those days I will pour out a portion of My spirit, and they shall prophesy:"

- <u>Hebrews 11:1-2</u> state, "Now, faith is a confident expectation of things hoped for; a convincement of the mind with respect to the reality of things not seen. By this therefore the ancients obtained reputation."
- <u>I Peter 1:3-5</u> state, "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who, according to His abundant mercy, hath regenerated us to a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead – for an inheritance incorruptible, incapable of defilement or decay, reserved in heaven for us who are, during belief, kept safely by the power of God, for a deliverance prepared to be revealed in the last time;"

• <u>I Peter 1:17-21</u> state, "And since you invoke, as Father, Him who without respect of persons judgeth every one according to his work, pass the time of your sojourning in fear; knowing that from that vain course of life, handed down to you from your fathers, you have been redeemed not with perishable things such as silver and gold, but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot, foreordained indeed before the foundation of the world, and manifested in these last times, for the sake of you who by Him believe in God, who hath raised Him from the dead, and hath given Him glory, so that you may have faith and hope in God."

- <u>I John 2:18</u> states, "Children, the last period is come: and as you have heard that the Antichrist cometh, there are even now many Antichrists, by which we know that it is the last period."
- <u>Jude 17-19</u> state, "But as for you, beloved, remember what the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ foretold you. For they assured you that in the last time there would be scoffers, walking after their own wicked desires. These are they who separate themselves, being sensual, and not having the spirit."

41. Are the heathen nations aligned against the Jews only?

- <u>Read Psalm 83</u> A Psalm by Asaph with regard to the enemy nations coming up against God and the nations of Israel.
- <u>Joel 3:9</u> states, "Because the Lord hath spoken, proclaim these things among the nations. Declare war: rouse the warriors: assemble and march up, all ye men of war."

42. Are the Jews a hidden people?

- <u>Psalm 83:3-4</u> state, "Against Thy people (Israel) they have taken craft counsel. And consulted against Thy holies. Come, said they, let us cut them off from being a nation: and let the name of Israel be no more remembered."
- <u>Isaiah 3:9</u> states, "Because their (the Jews) glory is now humbled; and the shame of their countenance is risen up against them: their sin therefore, like the Sodomites, they proclaimed and openly avowed. Alas for the souls! Because they have counselled an evil counsel against themselves,"

43. Are the Jews described nationally as a great lion?

- <u>Genesis 49:9</u> states, "<u>Juda</u> is a lion's whelp, from a vigorous stem, my son, thou art sprung. Couching down thou art gone to sleep like a young lion: Who dare rouse him!"
- <u>Numbers 23:24</u> states, "Behold the people (Israel) will rouse like a young lion; and, like an old lion, exult with pride. They will not go to rest till they devour prey until they have drunk the blood of the slain."
- <u>Numbers 24:9</u> states, "Couching down, he (Israel) is gone to rest, like a lion – yes like a young lion; who dare rouse him? Blessed are they who bless thee, and they who curse thee are already cursed."

44. Does judgment come to the Jews only?

- <u>Read the Book of Obadiah</u> Obadiah is the prophet who deals with YAHWEH's judgment of Esau/Edom/Jewry.
- <u>Read Leviticus 26:18-28</u> This is the part of the chapter with regard to YAHWEH's seven times pronouncement of judgment on Israel for their sins against Him.
- <u>Psalm 95:10</u> states, "Forty years. I was incensed with that generation (Israel), and said, They do always err with the heart and have not known My ways; so in Mine indignation, I solemnly said, They shall not enter into My rest."

44. Does judgment come to the Jews only?

• <u>Ezekiel 4:4-6</u> state, "And thou (Ezekiel) shalt lie on thy left side and lay on it the iniquities of the house of Israel. According to the number of the hundred and fifty days which thou shalt lie upon it thou shalt bear their iniquities. Now I have given thee their iniquities to the number of a hundred and ninety days. So when thou hast taken the iniquities of the house of Israel and finished them, thou shalt lie on thy right side and bear the iniquities of the house of Juda forty days. I have given thee a day for a year."

45. Are the Jews the house of Israel and the house of Judah – two nations and families?

- <u>Read Ezekiel 37</u> The parable of the dry bones which represent the whole house of Israel and the parable of the two staffs one is for Juda and the children of Israel who adhere to him AND for Joseph the staff of Ephraim, and for all the children of Israel who adhere to him.
- Jeremiah 3:18 states, "In those days the house of Juda shall unite with the house of Israel, and they shall come together from the land of the north and from all those countries, to the land which I put in possession of their fathers."
- Jeremiah 31:31 states, "Behold the days are coming, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Juda."

45. Are the Jews the house of Israel and the house of Judah – two nations and families?

• Jeremiah 33:24 (KJV) states, "Considerest thou not what this people have spoken, saying, The two families which the LORD hath chosen, He hath even cast them off? Thus they have despised My people, that they should be no more a nation before them."

46. Are the Jews called "great"?

• <u>Genesis 12:1-3</u> state, "NOW the Lord said to Abram, Depart from thy land and from thy kindred and from the house of thy father and come to the land which I will shew thee, and <u>I will make thee a great nation</u>; and thou shalt be blessed; and I will bless them, who bless thee; and those who curse thee I will curse: and by thee all the tribes of the earth shalt be blessed."

47. Have the Jews released those in slavery?

- <u>Isaiah 42:6-7</u> state, "I the Lord God have called thee unto righteousness, and I will take hold of thy hand and strengthen thee; for I have given thee for the covenant of a race – for the light of nations: to open the eyes of the blind; to lead out from chains them who are bound; and out of prison, them who are sitting in darkness."
- <u>Isaiah 58:6</u> states, "It is not such a fast as this that I have chosen, saith the Lord. But loose every bond of iniquity; dissolve the obligations of onerous contracts; set at liberty them who are oppressed, and tear in pieces every unjust stipulation in writing:"

48. Have the Jews colonized any people?

- <u>Genesis 28:14</u> states, "And thy (Jacob) seed shall be as the dust of the earth and shall spread abroad to the west and the south, and the north and the east. And by thee all the tribes of the earth shall be blessed, namely by the seed of thee."
- <u>Isaiah 49:8</u> states, "Thus saith the Lord, In an acceptable time I have hearkened to thee (Israel), and in a day of salvation helped thee; and have formed thee and given thee for the covenant of nations that thou mayst reduce the earth to order and possess desolate heritages,"

49. Are the Jews an island people?

- <u>Isaiah 24:15</u> states, "The water of the sea will be troubled: for this cause the glory of the Lord will be in the isles of the sea. In the isles of the sea the name of the Lord will be glorious."
- <u>Isaiah 41:1</u> states, "DEDICATE yourselves to Me, O Islands, for the Archons will gather new strength. Let them draw near and confer together, then let them announce judgment."
- <u>Isaiah 42:10</u> states, "Sing to the Lord a new song, ye, His government! Praise His name, ye from the utmost border of the earth, ye who go down on the sea and navigate it, ye islands, and ye who dwell therein."

49. Are the Jews an island people?

- <u>Isaiah 43:4-7</u> state, "Because thou (Israel) hast been precious in My sight hast been honored and I loved thee; therefore I will give men for thee and chiefs for thy life. Fear not. Because I am with thee, from the east I will bring thy seed, and gather thee together from the west: I will say to the north, Give up; and to the south, Keep thou not back; bring My sons from afar and My daughters from the ends of the earth all that are called by My name. For I have prepared him for My glory, I have fashioned him and made him,"
- <u>Isaiah 49:1</u> states, "HEARKEN to Me, O isles; and ye nations attend: after a long time one will arise, saith the Lord."

49. Are the Jews an island people?

- Jeremiah 23:8 (KJV) states, "But, The LORD liveth, which brought up and which led the seed of the house of Israel out of the north country, and from all countries whither I have driven them; and they shall dwell in their own land."
- Jeremiah 31:10 states, "Hear the words of the Lord, ye nations! And proclaim them to the far distant isles. Say, He who scattered Israel will gather them, and guard them as a shepherd doth his flock."


<u>Isaiah 43:10-13</u> state, "Be you witnesses for Me: and as for Me I Myself am a witness saith the Lord God: and this servant of Mine whom I have chosen (Israel); that you may know and believe and understand that with respect to Me, *The I Am*, There is no other God before Me; and after Me none will exist. I am God and there is no Savior besides Me. I have announced and saved; I reproached when there was no strange god among you. You are witnesses for Me; and I the Lord am still the same God from the beginning; and there is none who can rescue out of My hands. I will act; and who can prevent it"

- <u>Isaiah 52:6</u> states, "Thus saith the Lord, On your account My name is continually reviled among the nations. Therefore in that day My people (Israel) shall know My name. Because I *The I Am*, the same Who am speaking, am at hand,"
- <u>Matthew 1:21-23</u> state, "and she will bear a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS, for He will save His people for their sins. All this was done, so that there was a fulfilment of what was spoken by the prophet, saying, "The virgin shall conceive and bear a son and thou shalt call His name Emmanuel," the meaning of which is *God with us*:"


• Luke 1:67-75 state, "And Zacharias his father was filled with a holy spirit, and he prophesied, saying, Blessed be the Lord, the God of Israel; because He hath visited and delivered His people. He indeed hath raised up for us a horn of salvation in the house of His servant David (as He spake by the mouth of His holy prophets of old) -adeliverance from our enemies, and out of the hand of all who hate us – in kindness to our fathers, and in remembrance of His holy covenant (as He sware to our father Abraham) that He would grant us, that we, being delivered out of the hands of our enemies, may serve Him without fear, in holiness and righteousness before Him, all the days of our life."


• John 8:23-29 state, "Then He said to them (the Jews), You are from below; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world; therefore I said to you, You will die in your sins: for if you do not believe that I Am, you will die in your sins. Upon this they said to Him, Who art thou? And Jesus said to them, I am what I told you at the beginning, and am now telling you. I have many things to speak and to judge respecting you. He indeed who sent Me is true, and I speak to the world what I have heard from Him. They did not know that he was speaking to them of the Father; therefore Jesus said to them, When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know who I am; and that I do nothing of Myself; but speak these things as My Father taught Me. He indeed who sent Me is with Me. The Father hath not left Me alone, because I do always the things which are pleasing to Him."


- <u>Acts 3:13-15</u> state, "The God of Abraham, and Isaak, and Jacob the God of our fathers hath glorified His servant Jesus whom ye (the Jews) delivered up. Yes, you renounced Him in the presence of Pilate, when he had determined to release Him: you indeed renounced the Holy One and the Just and desired a murderer to be granted to you. You indeed killed Him who is the conductor to life, whom God hath raised from the dead, of which we are witnesses."
- <u>I Timothy 3:16</u> states, "The pillar and firm support of the truth is (and unquestionably great is the mystery of this religion,) *God hath been manifested in flesh, justified by spirit, hath appeared to messengers, been proclaimed among nations, believed on in the world, taken up in glory.*"
